

## Custom Airbrush by Patti

**Products to avoid** – These may make the AirBrush Tan Lighten or Fade or become Blotchy

Dove shower gel or Dove soap

Curel Lotion

Hair inhibiting lotions such as Jergens tend to make the tan yellow

Alpha hydroxyl acids, Beta Hydroxy acids, Glycolic acids Citric & Tartaric acids Salicylic acids

Toners containing Witch Hazel or Alcohol

Anti acne products that exfoliate the skin

Make-up remover, Products to remove eye make-up

Bar soaps of the deodorant varieties or anti bacterial

Use of loofas or scrub-mitt (use wash cloth during tan)

Band-aids or adhesive tapes of any sort

Facial masks

Exfoliating scrubs

Wax hair removers

Bug spray should be sprayed on clothing and avoid directly on skin

Hair dpilatory removes (Nair Neet etc)

Shaving exfoliates the skin therefore fading the tan

Use a new and clean razor with a lubricating product such as hai conditioner

Rinse off the conditioner when shaving is complete

Use of a dull blade will exfoliate skin more than a sharp new blade

Drying after a shower should be done by patting the skin. Avoid rubbing

Hot tubs, chlorine pools, salt water, Even a long hot bath will affect color

Women's tans may develop differently during various hormonal cycles. (Pregnancy, menstruation, menopause)

Oily skin may develop a lighter tan than dry skin
